Press Release (Oshawa):

The Oshawa Curling Club will host the 2007 Bantam Boys and Bantam Girls Provincial Curling Championships on February 8 to 11, 2007. This Ontario Curling Association (OCA) event offers the eight best boys' and eight best girls' curling teams from across the southern part of the province to opportunity to compete for the provincial title. Curlers participating in this event are 17 years of age or younger and will have won the privilege of competing in this event by advancing through two levels of "play downs" in "zone" and "regional" competitions in January.

Opening ceremonies will take place on Thursday evening, February 8 at 6 p.m. with the traditional "piping" of the curlers onto the ice to witness the ceremonial first rock and the toast to the opening of the games.

Each set of teams will participate in their respective seven-game round-robin play. Eight-end games will be played mornings at 10 a.m. and afternoons at 2 p.m. on February 8, 9, and 10. One evening game will be held on February 10 at 7 p.m. In the event of a tie, additional games will be played on Sunday, February 11. The girls' team and the boys' team with the most wins each will claim the OCA provincial title.

Spectators are welcome to witness some of the best youth curling in the province.
