That means that any other sport should generally be secondary to curling training sessions, games, bonspiels and playdowns during these seasons.

In addition, we have read, and agree to be bound by the Player and Parent Code of Conduct Agreement.

Player Obligation

Curling, like any other sport, requires dedication and commitment to maximize any individuals potential. Just playing as a member of a team will not foster growth and skill development. I can maximize my development by being an active and focused participant. This includes:

- Being on-time to all practices, games and other team events
- Communicating frequently with my coaches and listening to them as well
- Focusing and working hard during all team events
- Playing hard to maximize my enjoyment of the game
- Providing the best support possible to my teammates to help them improve

Financial Obligation

A financial commitment will be required in the form of monthly installments representing each participant’s portion of an overall team budget. An estimate of the team budget has been provided to you. Upon signing you will be required to pay a deposit of \$100.00 towards your annual fee. The remainder will be due in installments once the final team budget has been approved.

Players Code

- I will play fair, and follow the rules of the game.
- I will respect all opponents and their effort.
- I will be humble and realize that my individual accomplishments are only possible because of my teammates.

Parents Code

Parents are vital to the development of young athletes. Whether sitting in the stands or helping out as a volunteer, parents must set a positive example. Parents and adults involved in youth sports should be models of good sportsmanship and lead by example on and off the playing field.

- Give constructive criticism during a private moment, never in front of other parents, players, officials, spectators, etc.
- Support your coach and refrain from “sideline coaching” from the stands.
- Refrain from using profanity.
- Accept the decisions of officials and coaches as being fair
- Do not criticize an opposing team, its players, fans, coaches or team by words or gestures.
- Support the coaches, players and officials and help teach the value of commitment to the teams, sportsmanship, ethical conduct and fair play.
- Inappropriate behavior is cause for immediate ejection from the stands. Repeat offenses will result in being barred from future games and league sponsored activities.
- Parents will not encourage their child or any other person to engage in un-sportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participants, officials or any other attendee.
- Respect the “24 hour” rule prior to communicating with a coach or official regarding any negative event
